Philippians Chapter Study

The goal of this study is to help you gain a general understanding of the contents of the book of Philippians. We will do this by going through the book one chapter at a time, reading each chapter through several times, answering some questions about the content, and summarizing the central thoughts. Depending on the length of the chapter you are studying, you can complete a chapter summary in 20 to 30 minutes. Each chapter of the book will have ten questions or writing prompts that you will complete after you are done with the reading. These prompts will help you identify the central topic and go deeper in your understanding of what God wants you to learn from it.

You will start each study session by reading through a chapter in Philippians, implementing the directions below. Then you will move on to the writing prompts which are defined in the next pages.

Read a Chapter

- Read it without notes and without stopping.
- Read it in several different translations.
- Read it aloud quietly.

Caption the Chapter

- Write a 1-5 word description of the chapter.

Contents

- Describe, summarize, paraphrase or list the major points from the chapter.

Characters

- List the main characters from the chapter

Choose a Verse

- What verse either summarizes the chapter or speaks to you personally?

Crucial Words

- Write down what you think would be a key or important word in the chapter, there may be more than one.



Challenges

- List any challenges you have with the chapter:
 - Things you don't understand
 - Problems or questions you would like to study further.

Cross-Reference

- Look up other verses that help clarify what the chapter is talking about.

Christ Seen?

- What do you see that says something about Jesus, the Holy Spirit, or God in this chapter?
- What can you learn about the nature of Jesus from this chapter?
- What attributes of God in Christ are illustrated here?

Central Lesson(s)

- Write down major principles or insights.
 - Why does God want this passage in the Bible?
 - What does God want to teach me from this?
 - What is the central thought the writer is trying to develop?

Conclusions

Apply Scripture to your life:

- Tell God you are ready to obey what He shows you.

2. Make a personal game plan.

- Write down insights you discovered through your meditation and how you will apply the scripture to your life
- Make it personal - write it in first person

- Make it provable and measurable - set a time limit to take action.

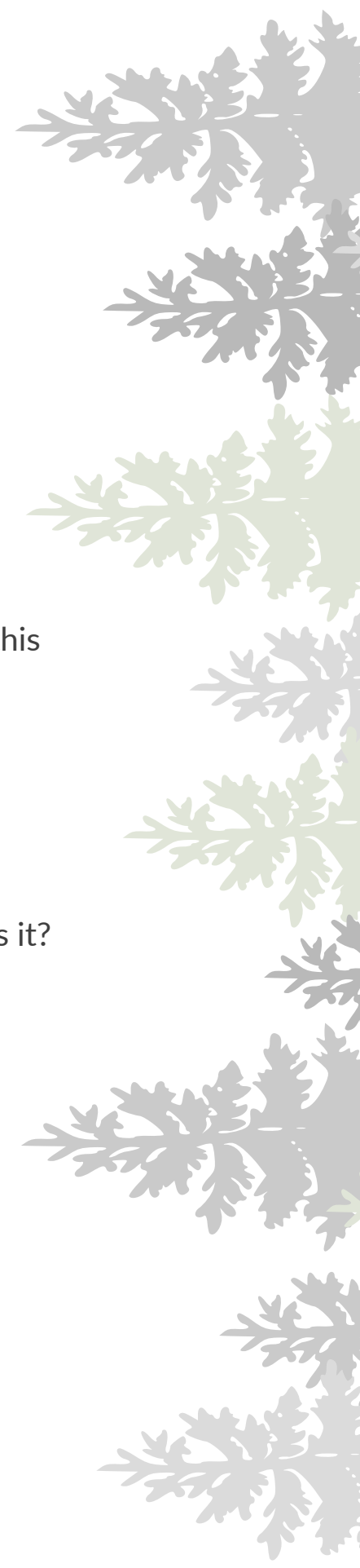

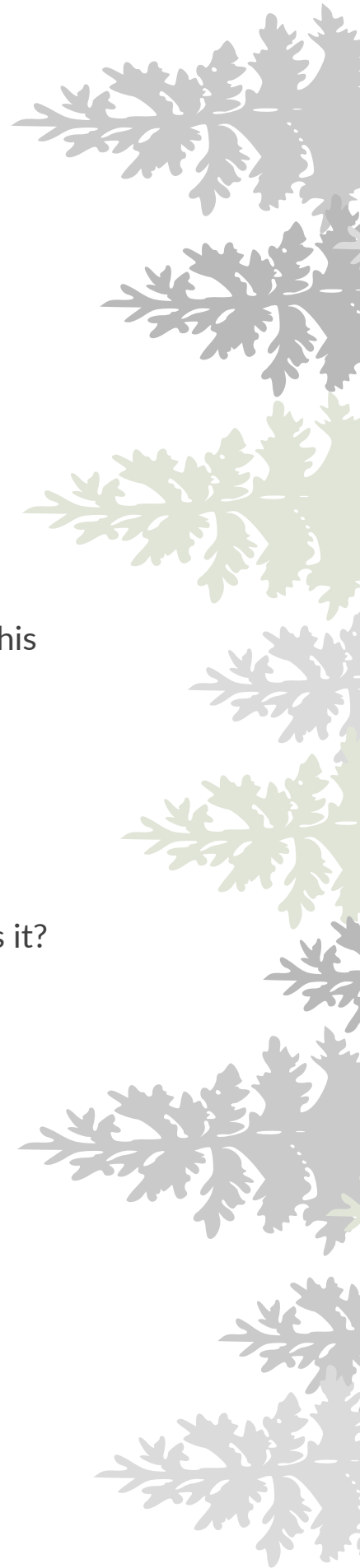
